

# Installing Acrobat Reader (Acroread) on Debian 10 Buster Linux HOWTO

First we need to add the i386 architecture:

```
sudo dpkg --add-architecture i386
sudo apt-get update
```

Then add libxml2:i386:

```
sudo apt-get install libxml2:i386
```

Download the Adobe Acrobat Reader (acroread) package here:

[ftp://ftp.adobe.com/pub/adobe/reader/un ... ux\\_enu.deb](ftp://ftp.adobe.com/pub/adobe/reader/un...ux_enu.deb)

Install it as follows:

```
cd ~/Downloads
sudo dpkg -i AdbRdr9.5.5-1_i386linux_enu.deb
```

He may complain, but that's fine. Then type:

```
sudo apt-get -f install
```

and various dependencies will be installed. You should be able to run acroread from the prompt:

```
acroread
```

Acroread is still the only pdf reader that can correctly play animations (sequences of pdf images) on Debian Linux.
